
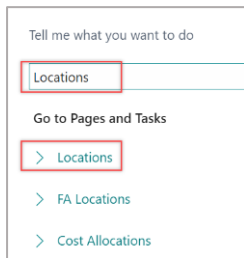


This document is a walk-through of all the setups required to create a pick document from a sales order. You need to configure the following setups:

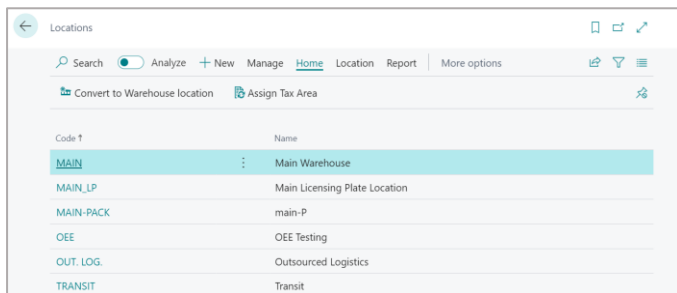
- Location Setup
- Warehouse Setup

## Location Setup

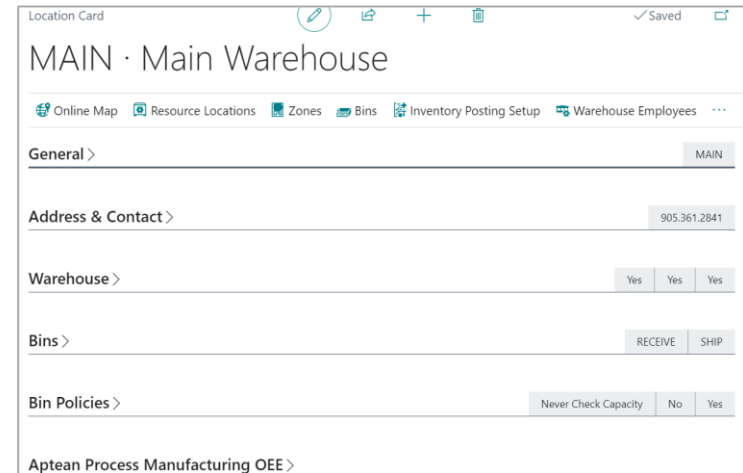
1. Select the Search icon , enter **Locations**, and then choose the related link.



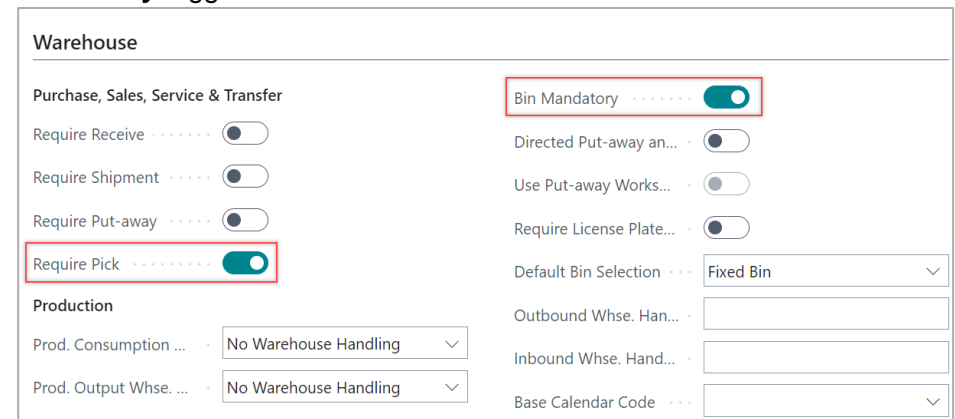
The **Locations** page opens.



2. Select the required **Code**.  
The **Location Card** page opens.



3. On the **Warehouse** FastTab, turn on the **Require Pick** and **Bin Mandatory** toggles.



4. On the **Bins** FastTab, select the **Shipment Bin Code**.
